

Copyright issues when completing a "paper" dissertation, "paper" final thesis, or "paper" master's thesis (cumulative academic theses containing pdf versions of the published articles).

Academic theses are publicly available publications. **Please be advised**, however, that certain publishers **do not permit** the use of pdf versions of published articles in theses and dissertations.

In order to avoid copyright issues, it is **recommended** to use only the links to the published articles in such theses. An alternative, of course, is to clarify in advance with the relevant publishers whether and in what form inclusion of published articles in an academic thesis is accepted in each individual case.
